The big challenge for Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman, whose first full-year budget (Feb 1, 2020) coincided with the onset of coronavirus in India, was negotiating the macroeconomic crisis that followed. Now, as the threat seems to abate, multiple green shoots of revival are visible. In an exclusive interaction with Fortune India, Sitharaman explains how the government handled the pandemic, how daily monitoring of credit guarantee schemes helped disbursals, and why she believes that India will be among the fastest growing economies in the years ahead.

THE MACRO PICTURE

CEOs of businesses entrenched in rural India say it's holding up the economy due to the stimulus. In the first quarter, GDP grew 20%, albeit on a low base. What progress do you expect on economic growth in this year and the next?

On never losing the opportunity—
whenever it arises—of expanding the
domain of people who are benefitted
by steps that you take, I certainly
would think the exemplar before me
is Prime Minister Narendra Modi.
He has attempted at every moment
to ensure that the steps he takes,
the policy changes he brings in, his
intervention into the economy and
the relief that he provides to the
masses are aimed at the bottom-most
level, which is the most remote from
decision-making centres—the com-

mon man and small businesses.

Using technology, PM Modi tries to reach out to all sections of people. So, on that score, my exemplar obviously is before me. The person who guides everything that we do in this ministry is the prime minister.

Similarly, being given that opportunity, I have kept that (idea) before me, because I also come from a middleclass background and understand the struggle that people face, especially in this kind of a situation.

There are clear-cut indications of confidence in the Indian economy, and with vaccination, there is trust that we can overcome this problem. Therefore, the indicators that you see—be it electricity consumption, growth of core industries, demand for raw materials—all indicate that the economy is on the recovery path. At present, we have our first electric motorcycle in the pipeline. It will be a high-speed motorcycle which will be 100 percent Made in India."

"We manufacture and sell our products through our network of over 400 dealers across India. Our business strategy revolves around innovating the products to offer maximum localization and high quality. We aim to achieve rigorous technological advancements, which is the demand of the market."

"Our first milestone was when we became the first manufacturer to get FAME-II approval in the Electric-2-wheeler segment, which added a lot of credibility to our brand. Our second milestone was in 2018 when we organized a ride on our e-scooter I Praise from Gurugram to Khardung La pass in Ladakh, which is the highest motorable path in India at an altitude of 18379 ft, covering 1350 kms.

her career from medicine to entrepreneurship with her husband, initiating a revolution of EV mobility in India. Today Okinawa is amongst the top two highest-selling Electric-2-wheeler brand in India.

While Rupali directs headfirst the vision of the company, he primes the product and engineering teams to constantly modernize and produce top resonating Vehicles.

Okinawa set up its corporate base in Gurugram, with its manufacturing unit in Alwar, Rajasthan. The first two years were spent on market research, understanding the customer requirements and challenges, development of the entire supplier base, prototype formation, endurance testing and taking care of other parameters. The first prototype was tested for 25,000 km on different road conditions. Based on the results, Okinawa improved its prototype and launched its first product, a high-speed scooter RIDGE in 2017.

At present, it has six electric scooters in its portfolio in the price range of Rs 61,998 to Rs 105,990 lakh. We offer the largest range of high speed and low speed electric-2-wheelers for the MASSES.

In the low-speed range, OKINAWA AUTOTECH offers Okinawa R30, Okinawa Lite, and Okinawa Dual. On the other hand, the three high-speed products are Okinawa Ridge+, Okinawa Praise Pro, and Okinawa iPraise+. It is also planning to launch two more new high-speed two-wheelers this year.
